1.0 PROVISION CONTENT

The provision shall comprise four main elements to be delivered in an integrated manner, not isolated subjects.

2.0 MANDATORY OUTCOMES

Achievement in these will be assessed by verification through the appropriate awarding body certificate.

- Food Processing and Cooking
- Front Office
- Housekeeping
- Food & Drink Service
- Food & Drink Service (Drinks Service)
- Hospitality Services (Multi-skilled)

4.0 RELATED KNOWLEDGE

Induction covering workplace Employment Rights and Responsibilities (ERR) must be completed. Proof of the induction process having taken place will be required when claiming certification. The evidence for this will be an approved and signed copy of the Employment Rights and Responsibilities induction component, a copy of which can be obtained from People 1st.
